The title of each exhibit is composed of its ①shape, ②design, and ③type of object.

② Design

Production place

For the dates, we use the Gregorian calendar.

Description of the design appears in the middle of the title, using distinctive motifs.

① Shape

Description of the size of an object appears first in the title. The Kyushu Ceramic Museum classifies a dish with mouth diameter less than 16cm as a 'small dish', more than 30cm as a 'large dish'. The shape is given next to the size.
